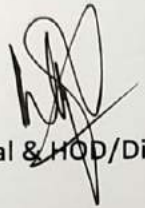

On the day of inauguration function of first year BCA students we had invited Mr. Gali Swamy, Secretary, DSI and Mr. Manikantan, Head – Mphasis &amp; Mr. Pramod, Director – Mind Tree for the event. Mr. Gali Swamy, Mr. Pramod &amp; Mr. Manikantan were the chief guest to the event. Mr. Pramod &amp; Mr. Manikantan gave a speech about their present companies along with that they gave information about the recent technologies which are going in our countries &amp; corporate industry.            Later to it Prof. Hemanth Uppala gave the introduction of our college, like Academics, clubs like Coding, HR, loud, marketing, financial club. And about non- academics like sports and extra circular activities and laser and opportunities provided by our college. And a Small introduction about placements and Job offers. The next session was followed by            Mr. Arun Salwan talked upon Cloud Computing and how it is delivering computing services which includes Servers, storage, database, networking etc. later he informed about how a cloud can store huge amount of data and he informed about the types of cloud and how a common man can store his data in cloud &amp; later he gave examples on how IT Companies &amp; Banking sectors etc. are opting cloud technology.</p> <p><b>Day 3 (10-09-22):</b>            On the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of induction program was about the “Alumni Interaction”, where students had an opportunity to meet our Alumni Mr. Mohit Agarwal. 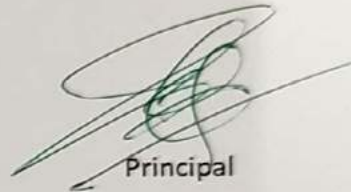

They had an interaction with students and gave information about mental health. During the talk they said anxiety &amp; depression are normal to everyone but how you have to overcome from these things like anxiety &amp; depression, as they are the counsellors, they provide counselling session for the students who needs to overcome these anxiety &amp; depressions. Later to it they also gave a very good suggestions how to overcome Mental Health.</p> <p><b>Day 5 (13-09-22):</b></p> <p>The day 5 lecture was delivered by Mr. Ramesh K N, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Karnataka State Police Department and the event was presided over by the Vice Principal and attended by the College Anti Ragging Committee and Students of BCA First Year.</p> <p>Mr. Ramesh K N in his address to the students spoke about Rights and duties of a citizen, how will serve as a guide to human conduct and relationship in the society. He also said how Self-motivated people will have the tendency upon working. It pushes an individual to achieve goals, feel fulfilled and improve their quality of life. Then he started to about discipline, how a person should be disciplined in every aspect of life and also, he stated that how everyone follow discipline in his/her life in a different form. Besides, everyone has his own prospect of discipline. Some people consider it a part of their life and some don't. It is the guide that availability directs a person on the right path. He mentioned that without discipline, the life of a person will become dull and inactive. Also, a disciplined person can control and handle the situation of living in a sophisticated way than those who do not.
