Akshaya Patra is a non-profit organization headquartered in Bangalore at India. It strives to eliminate classroom hunger by implementing the mid-day meal programme. It provides nutritious meal to children studying in government and govt-aided schools. It also aims to counter malnutrition and support right to education of children hailing from socio-economically challenging backgrounds.

It all started in the year 2000, with humble beginning of serving just 1500 children across 5 schools, their programme has become the world’s largest mid-day meal programme serving wholesome food over 1.6 million children from 13839 schools across 12 states in India. They are working with 6500 employees in the kitchen.
