The guide walked us through the different stages of coffee production. We learned about the three major types of coffee seeds grown on the estate—Arabica, Robusta, and Liberica. Each type had its own unique characteristics, and it was fascinating to understand how factors like altitude, climate, and soil affected the taste of the coffee. In addition to coffee, the estate also grows a variety of other crops, including cocoa, cinnamon, cardamom, tapioca, and pepper. The guide explained how these crops are cultivated alongside coffee, contributing to the estate's sustainability and biodiversity. This intercropping technique not only maximizes land use but also ensures a balance of nutrients in the soil. One of the most intriguing parts of the tour was learning about the evolution of coffee-making equipment. From traditional grinding methods using hand-cranked tools to modern machines, we saw how technology has changed the way coffee is produced and consumed. The guide also explained the different methods of coffee preparation used in various parts of the world, adding to our global perspective on the beverage. Finally, the most awaited part of the visit—the coffee tasting session. We were offered freshly brewed coffee made from the estate's own beans. The aroma was rich and inviting, and the taste was nothing short of exceptional. Each sip was a reminder of the effort and expertise that goes into every cup of coffee we enjoy. After a fulfilling day of learning about coffee and experiencing the plantation's offerings, we returned to the resort.




Figure 3: Coffee History




Figure 5: Modern Coffee roasting




Figure 14: Black Pepper cultivation




Figure 16:Bay leaf and Cinnamon cultivation


