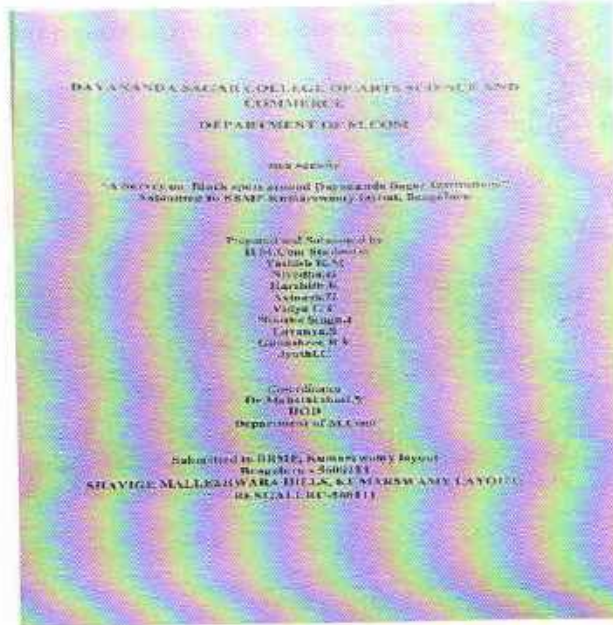
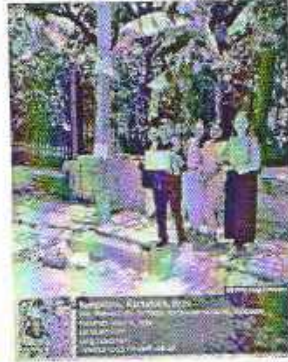

**By 2<sup>nd</sup> year M.COM students**

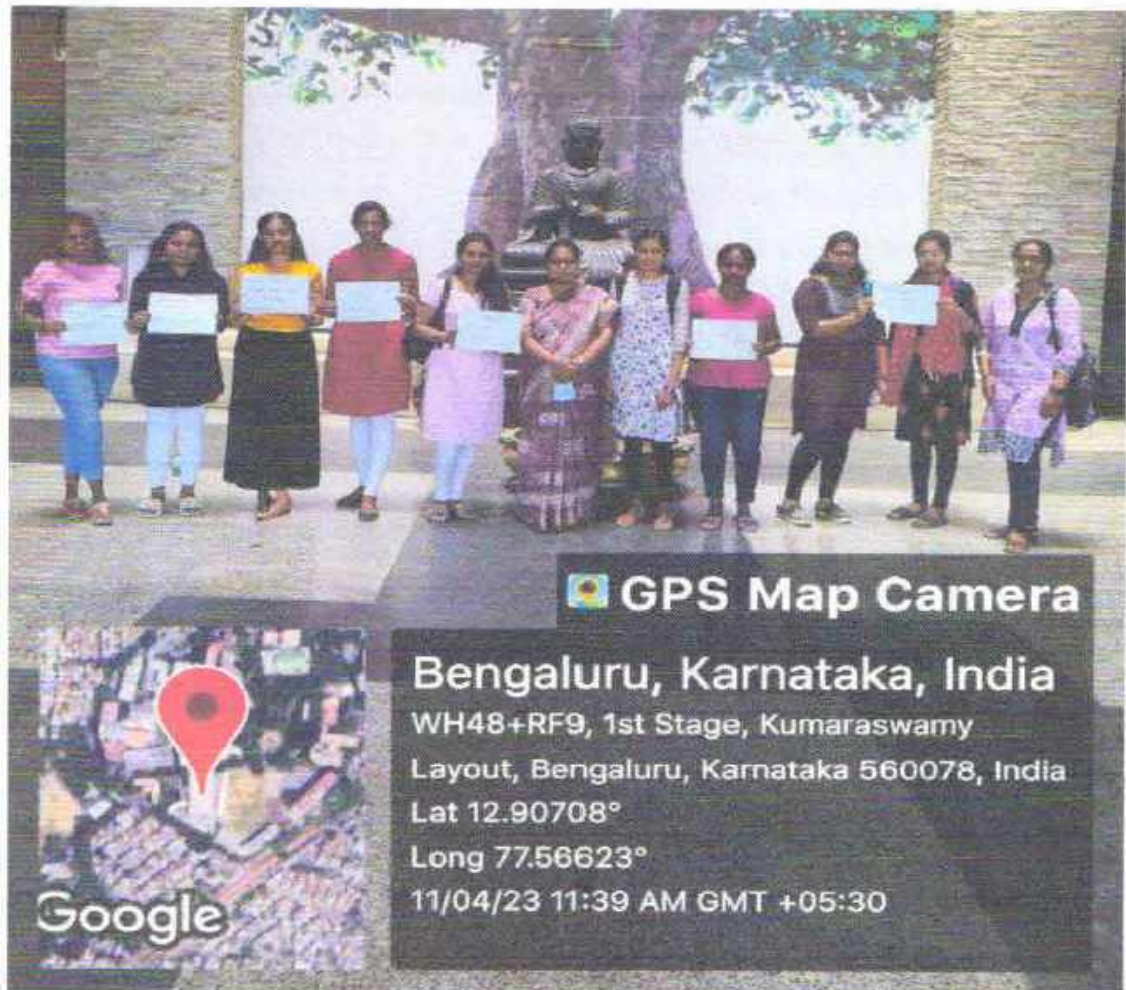
#### **Introduction**

A city well reputed as the “silicon valley of India” and the “IT capital of India” is an home to many educational and research institutes like NIMHANS, IIMG, ISRO is the second fastest growing and developing Indian city.

Bangalore is famous as the “Garden city of India” because of its gentle climate, greenery and the presence of Public Park like Lal bhag and Cubbon Park. But today Bangalore is struggling to keep up its label of “The Garden City Of India” because the city generates approximately 4500 tonnes of garbage everyday which is transported to the outskirts of the city to the landfills of Doddaballapur, Mandur and Mavallipura.

This report is to identity and analyzes the presence of blackspots located at kumaraswamy layout near Dayananda Sagar College. We are glad that we were part of this activity which was conducted on 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2023, Tuesday because of which we were able to know the black spots and little contribution towards curbing the causes of bad health issues, breeding of mosquitos, stagnation of water, consumption of plastics by animals etc. This black spot may also affect the surroundings such as schools, college, hospital, road side vendors and fruit stalls etc.





## Objective

- The main objective of this activity was to create awareness among the public not to create black spot which is harmful to their own health and also to their kids and to bring it to the notice of local BBMP and to clear this spots on daily basis.
- To reduce the impact of pollution and garbage on environment
- To encourage reducing, recycling and reusing the waste and scrapes.

## **Purpose**

Bangaloreans have begun to dump the erratic garbage collection along the road sides. All this is a by-product of the "use and throw" culture. The drains, the pot-holes are overflowing with the waste. Animals are dying on a large scale by consuming plastics instead of grass, there is widespread of epidemic among the flora and fauna, climatic conditions, rainfall pattern are getting disturbed.

Though the city has door to door collection of garbage, there are still thousands of black spots where mixed waste continues to be dumped indiscriminately. Clearing this blackspots is proving to be a big challenge for BBMP. The main intension of this activity was to create awareness among the people and to stop them from throwing the waste on roads.

## Activity description

The black spots are the areas where the city residents dump garbage in the open even though the civil administration has deployed garbage collection vans for door to door waste collection and transports the same to the compost plant on the outskirts of the city. These black spots are located along the roads, streets, road corners at open space across the city.

As garbage being dumped on the road continuously to be one of the major problems in the city. We primarily began our rally with in our college campus starting from our M.COM department to college main gate, which created awareness among the students.
