The anti-ragging cell helps staff members to guide the newly admitted students to their appropriate classes during the induction program. Every academic year, a committee to combat ragging is formed, and the cautionary boards are installed at key locations around campus.


To establish a campus free of ragging, the anti-ragging cell, PRABALA, organizes awareness campaigns, quizzes, street plays, skits, and other events. To ensure the students' safety, the anti-ragging squad patrols sensitive areas such as parking lots, canteens, food courts, hostel grounds, etc. As a result, the committee does not receive a single ragging-related complaint. However, ragging awareness campaigns are a common occurrence on campuses.

At the time of admission, all students were required to sign anti-ragging undertakings in accordance with government directives. The document's submission validates the students' commitment to abiding by the government's anti-ragging program. For the convenience of the students, UGC Guidelines and a sample anti-ragging undertaking form were made available on the college website. Numerous initiatives have been made to raise student awareness of anti-ragging campaigns.


