Students actively participated in Eco Rally as a part of "*I care for my Environment*" theme to raise awareness about Global warming. Students and faculties started the rally around 9:30 AM from the main gate of our Institution. Marched through the interior areas of Kumaraswamy Layout.

During the march students accompanied by faculties interacted with Commuters and distributed few saplings to public. Traffic Police from Kumaraswamy Layout police station supported our students for safety purpose during the rally. The police asked the students to assemble in Bus


